Sermon Discussion Questions

Note: To give & receive the greatest benefit from this discussion, please review your own sermon notes, read & reflect on these discussion questions in advance.

1. Which of the arguments for life after death do you find most convincing and why?

- * i.e. **Nature** (planting seeds, caterpillars/butterflies) **Physics** (perpetual existence of "matter") **Philosophy** (desire for justice), **Anthropology** (universal longing of mankind), **Experience** (near-death or out-of-body).
- * Do you know anyone who has had a near-death or out-of-body experience? How did they describe it?
- * Which of the Bible accounts of life after death do you find most compelling i.e. Job 14:14-15, 19:25-27; Daniel 12:2; 1 Corinthians 15; Hebrews 9:27, others?

2. Please take time to read the "brochure" about heaven from *Revelation 21:1-27*, 22:1-55 (prior to the discussion if possible).

- * What parts of that description do you find particularly beautiful, interesting, confusing, inspiring or encouraging?
- * What are you looking forward to i.e. reunions, worship, service, understanding, exploration, discussions, seeing God/Jesus/Holy Spirit, mansions, gardens, galaxies etc?
- * What difference does the hope of eternal life there in heaven make during your life here on earth?

3. Please read these biblical descriptions of hell: *Matthew 13:41-42, 25:41-46; Revelation 20:11-15, 21:8.*

- * What aspects of hell, as described in the Bible, do you find most disturbing i.e. isolation, darkness, regret, fire, agony, justice etc?
- * What additional questions do these and other passages about hell raise in your mind
- * What good can come from a study and understanding of hell i.e. for ourselves, our loved ones, our community, our church or our world?
