



FAQs: LIMITED REOPENING FOR 10:00AM SUNDAY SERVICES

As of June 28, 2020

Is registration required to attend?

Yes, at this time all those planning to attend must register in advance due to our limited capacity. While walk-ins will not be permitted, we will allow registrations on-site (space allowing) and up to the start of the service start time. Registration will be available starting every Wednesday at 12:00 p.m. for the upcoming Sunday at www.centralchurchnyc.org/register.

What time should I arrive?

We ask that you arrive between 9:30-9:45 a.m. to allow for time to be seated as our service will start promptly at 10:00 a.m. along with our livestream.

Are there certain places to enter and exit the sanctuary?

Yes, attendees will be directed to enter at the Park Avenue entrance at the front of the church. You will then be directed to enter the sanctuary through the side chapel entrance near the elevators. At the end of the service, you will be dismissed through the back of the sanctuary and out the side door onto E. 64th Street.

Where will I sit?

You will be directed by an usher to sit only in designated pews that are distanced 6 feet apart. The main sanctuary along with the back and side balconies will be open for seating.

Will there be bulletins?

No, at this time there will not be printed bulletins. We recommend you view a digital Order of Worship on the Central Church NYC app which can be [downloaded here](#), or visit centralchurchnyc.org/bulletin.

Will there be an offertory?

At this time, we ask that you donate online by texting 'centralchurchnyc' to 77977 or visiting centralchurchnyc.org.

Will there be communion?

Beginning July 12, we are excited to offer communion as part of our worship service once again. Individually wrapped wafer and juice portions will be pre-distributed and made available in the pews for those who wish to partake.

Will there be music and singing?

A portion of the service will be dedicated to music, and attendees are encouraged to sing while wearing masks. Lyrics will be printed in the digital Order of Worship available on the Central Church NYC app.

Will there be childcare?

No, there will not be childcare or children's worship at this time. For families with young children, there will be an optional livestream available on the 6th floor. If you would like to make use of that room, please email Gretchen at groth@centralchurchnyc.org for further details.

Will restrooms be available?

Yes, men and women restrooms will be open on the mezzanine level only.

What are the guidelines I should follow while attending services?

In keeping with CDC and New York State guidelines, all individuals are required to wear a face covering or mask at all times while in the church building. We also kindly ask that you maintain a distance of 6 feet between yourself and others. If you develop any symptoms related to COVID-19 or have been exposed to anyone with COVID-19 in the past 14 days, we request that you abstain from joining us in person and watch online at www.centralchurchnyc.org/live.
