Deacon Nomination Service—Sunday Evening, May 19, 6 PM

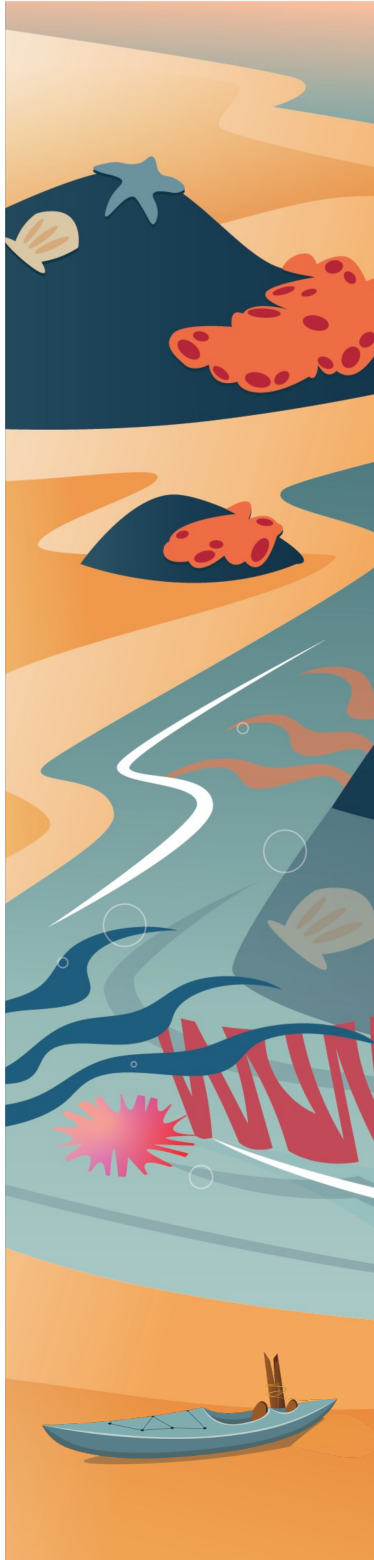

We will ask for nominees on Sunday Night, May 19, 2024, during the Sunday Evening Worship Service, 6 PM. Pastor Brian will first preach on the Biblical texts that speak to Deacon Qualifications, and then members will write down names of four nominees. Those nominations will be tallied by the Deacons, and the Pastor and Acting Deacon Chairman will begin speaking with those who received the most nominations until four men feel led to serve and are brought before the Church for final approval as Deacons. Please pray for God to call out those He desires to serve, and that His will is done through this entire process.
