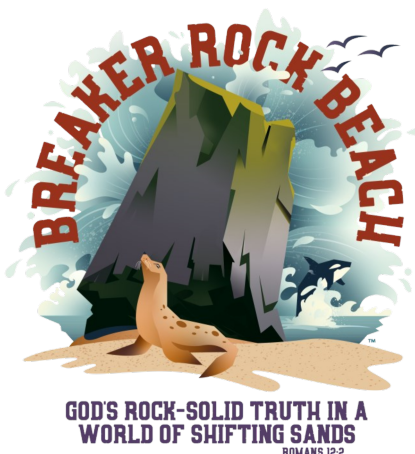

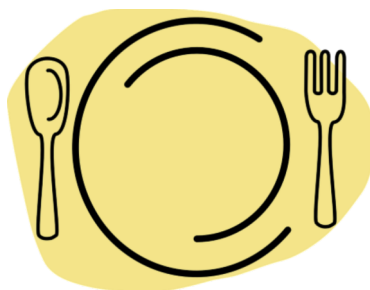
Here are some important things to know about this year's VBS:

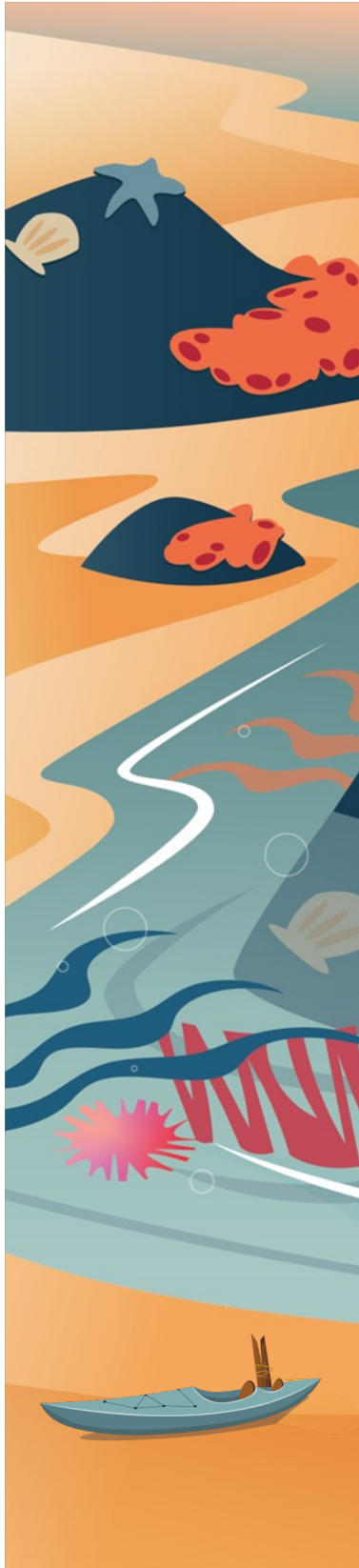
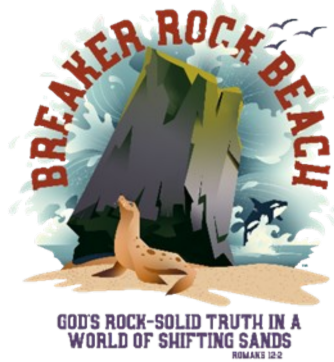


The McCunes in Concert Sunday, July 14, 6 PM

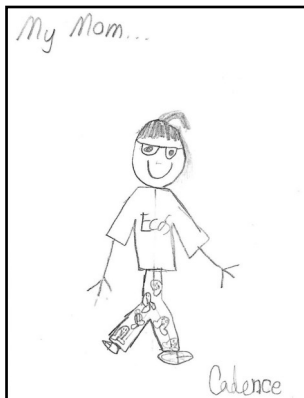

My Mom

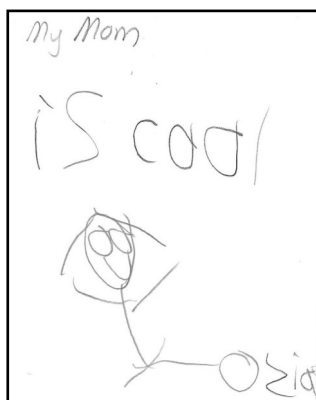
