Global Hunger Sunday

Right now, 828 million people around the world are facing hunger. War, famine, poverty, and rising food prices are pushing this number higher and higher.

In places near and far, people desperately need help and hope. Gifts on Global Hunger Sunday equip Send Relief to provide food, aid, and the hope of Christ to communities in need. This year, the focus is on four locations impacted by your gifts:

1. Appalachia (U.S.)
2. Guatemala
3. Nigeria
4. South Asia

More than 47 million people in the United States face hunger every day. More than one in five Guatemalans struggle with hunger. According to the UN, 5.4 million children in Nigeria face the threat of acute malnutrition. A staggering 134 million people in South Asia don't have access to clean drinking water.
