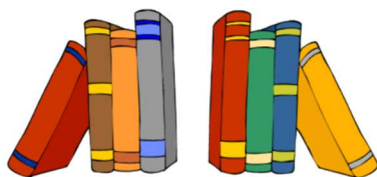

Bob Funk to Speak on MBC's Resound Transitional Pastor Ministry

November 16

On November 16th at the Evening Service, Bob Funk will present a devotion and speak on Resound Transitional Pastor Ministry. This is a ministry of the Missouri Baptist Convention, and the program is designed to help churches in transition.

Resound offers three options:

Pulpit Supply provides preaching for the church on a given Sunday morning and evening services as well as Wednesday evenings.

Interim Pastor serves the church through leading the regular services of the church and providing for general shepherding duties. This includes baptisms and the Lord's Supper, hospital visits, counseling, funerals and weddings.

Resound Transitional Pastor helps the church prepare for the next season of ministry, helps them search for their next pastor, and begin pursuing spiritual and missional renewal. In this option the Transitional Pastor does everything the Interim Pastor does plus –

- Deacon and committee meetings
- Business meetings
- Visitation
- Leads in assessing the church's current reality
- Leads in developing a plan for implementation
- Addresses issues & conflicts within the church
- Leadership development
- Helps the church prepare for a new pastor
- Training a pastor search committee
- Assist in mission development

There are several steps in the process

1. No Pastor
2. Explore Options with Resound Network
3. Church Vote – Process and Transitional Pastor Affirmed
4. Resound Process: Discovery through Recommendation
5. Church Vote – Recommendations Affirmed
6. Begin Implementation: Pastor Search and Spiritual & Missional Renewal
7. Church Vote – New Pastor
8. Continue Implementation with New Pastor

There are a few things to take note of:

1. The entire transition process can take from nine to eighteen months.
2. The church makes the decisions by voting at a Business Meeting on whether to use *Resound*, and which option to take.
3. *Resound* does not choose the Interim Pastor or the new Pastor for us. The church makes those decisions by voting at a Business Meeting.
4. Transitional pastors will usually have several years of ministry experience. They will also have completed training provided by the Missouri Baptist Convention.
5. The Concord Association has a list of men recommended by their office for pulpit supply that we can obtain.

Bob Funk will give us more information on November 16th. Please plan to attend so you will be fully informed on what this program can offer.
