Year 1 Verses in order:

1- 2 Tim. 3:16-17 (The Word)

<sup>16</sup> All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, <sup>17</sup> that the man of God[a] may be complete, equipped for every good work.

2- Col 4:2 (Prayer)

Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving.

3- Eph. 4:31-32 (Forgiveness)

<sup>31</sup> Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. <sup>32</sup> Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.

4- James 1:2-3 (Trials)

<sup>2</sup> Count it all joy, my brothers,[a] when you meet trials of various kinds, <sup>3</sup> for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness.

5- Ps. 86:15 (God's Character)

But you, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious,  
slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness.

6- 1 Peter 2:24 (Gospel)

He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.

7- 2 Tim. 1:7 (Fear)

for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.

8- Is. 65:24 (Prayer)

Before they call I will answer;  
while they are yet speaking I will hear.

9- 1 Cor. 10:13 (Temptation)

No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it

10- Gal. 6:1 (Church Life)

Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted.

11- Phil. 4:6-7 (Anxiety)

<sup>6</sup> do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. <sup>7</sup> And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

12- Phil. 4:8 (Anxiety)

Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things.

13- Eph. 2:8-9 (Gospel)

<sup>8</sup> For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, <sup>9</sup> not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

14- Eph. 2:10 (Gospel)

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

15- Heb. 4:15 (God's character)

For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin.

16- John 5:15 (Godly living)

The man went away and told the Jews that it was Jesus who had healed him.

17- Eph. 6:10-12 (Temptation)

<sup>10</sup> Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. <sup>11</sup> Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. <sup>12</sup> For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.

18- Ps. 77:13-14 (God's Character)

<sup>13</sup> Your way, O God, is holy. What god is great like our God? <sup>14</sup> You are the God who works wonders; you have made known your might among the peoples.

19- James 1:19-20 (Anger)

<sup>19</sup> Know this, my beloved brothers: let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger; <sup>20</sup> for the anger of man does not produce the righteousness of God.

20- Lam. 3:21-23 (Hope/Trust)

<sup>21</sup> But this I call to mind, and therefore I have hope: <sup>22</sup> The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; <sup>23</sup> they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.

21- Lam. 3:24-25 (Hope/Trust)

<sup>24</sup> "The Lord is my portion," says my soul, "therefore I will hope in him." <sup>25</sup> The Lord is good to those who wait for him, to the soul who seeks him.

22- Col.3:1-3 (Godly Living)

<sup>1</sup> If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. <sup>2</sup> Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth. <sup>3</sup> For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.

23- Matt. 18:15-16 (Church Life)

<sup>15</sup> "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault, between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have gained your brother. <sup>16</sup> But if he does not listen, take one or two others along with you, that every charge may be established by the evidence of two or three witnesses.

24- Matt. 18:17 (Church Life)

If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church. And if he refuses to listen even to the church, let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector.

25- 1 John 1:8-9 (Repentance)

<sup>8</sup> If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. <sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

26- 1 Cor. 13: 4-8a (Godly living)

<sup>4</sup> Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant <sup>5</sup> or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; [a] it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. <sup>7</sup> Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. <sup>8</sup> Love never ends.

27- Col. 1:15-16 (God's Character)

<sup>15</sup> He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. <sup>16</sup> For by[a] him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him.

28- Col. 1: 17-18 (God's Character)

<sup>17</sup> And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together. <sup>18</sup> And he is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be preeminent.

29- Col. 1:19-20 (God's Character)

<sup>19</sup> For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, <sup>20</sup> and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross.

30- Romans 8:26 (Prayer)

Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words.

31- Romans 8:28 (Trials)

And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good,[a] for those who are called according to his purpose.

32- Romans 8:38-39 (Trials)

<sup>38</sup> For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, <sup>39</sup> nor height nor depth, nor anything else, <sup>39</sup> in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

33- Prov. 15:1 (Godly speech)

A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.

34- Romans 8:1-2 (Gospel)

<sup>1</sup> There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. <sup>2</sup> For the law of the Spirit of life has set you[b] free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death.

35- Romans 8:3-4 (Gospel)

<sup>3</sup> For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin,[a] he condemned sin in the flesh, <sup>4</sup> in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

36- Romans 8:5-6 (Gospel)

<sup>5</sup> For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit. <sup>6</sup> For to set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace.

37- Romans 8:18 (Suffering)

For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us.

38- Psalm 73:25-26 (Strength)

<sup>25</sup> Whom have I in heaven but you? And there is nothing on earth that I desire besides you. <sup>26</sup> My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

39- James 4:7-8 (Temptation)

<sup>7</sup> Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. <sup>8</sup> Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

40- Romans 11:33 (God's Character)

Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways!

41- Romans 11:34-35 (God's Character)

<sup>34</sup> "For who has known the mind of the Lord, or who has been his counselor?" <sup>35</sup> "Or who has given a gift to him that he might be repaid?"

42- Gal. 6:10 (Church Life)

So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith.

43- Ps. 103:1-4 (Repentance)

<sup>1</sup> Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy name! <sup>2</sup> Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits, <sup>3</sup> who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases, <sup>4</sup> who redeems your life from the pit, who crowns you with steadfast love and mercy,

44- Ps. 103:8-9 (Repentance)

<sup>8</sup> The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. <sup>9</sup> He will not always chide, nor will he keep his anger forever.

45- Ps. 103:10-11 (Repentance)

<sup>10</sup> He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities. <sup>11</sup> For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him;

46- Ps. 103:12-13 (Repentance)

<sup>12</sup> as far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us. <sup>13</sup> As a father shows compassion to his children, so the Lord shows compassion to those who fear him.

47- Ps. 19:7-8 (The Word)

<sup>7</sup> The law of the Lord is perfect, reviving the soul; the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple; <sup>8</sup> the precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes;

48- 1 Jn. 2:15-16 (Temptation)

<sup>15</sup> Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. <sup>16</sup> For all that is in the world—the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride of life[a]—is not from the Father but is from the world.

49- 2 Cor. 12:9 (Strength)

But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

50- Matt. 5:23-24 (Church Life)

<sup>23</sup> So if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, <sup>24</sup> leave your gift there before the altar and go. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.

51- 2 Cor. 4:17-18

<sup>17</sup> For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison, <sup>18</sup> as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal.

52- 1 Cor. 10:31 (Godly Living)

So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

## Year 2 Verses In Order:

- 1- Col. 3:16 (The Word)  
Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.
- 2- Ps. 32:8 (Wisdom)  
I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my eye upon you.
- 3- Ps. 27:1 (Fear)  
The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold[a] of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?
- 4- Deut.7:9 (God's Character)  
Know therefore that the Lord your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations,
- 5- Heb. 12:14-15 (Godly living)  
<sup>14</sup> Strive for peace with everyone, and for the holiness without which no one will see the Lord. <sup>15</sup> See to it that no one fails to obtain the grace of God; that no "root of bitterness" springs up and causes trouble, and by it many become defiled;
- 6- Rom. 3:23 (Gospel)  
for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
- 7- Rom. 3:24 (Gospel)  
and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,
- 8- Psalm 145:17-18 (God's Character)  
<sup>17</sup> The Lord is righteous in all his ways and kind in all his works. <sup>18</sup> The Lord is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth.
- 9- Gal. 2:20 (Godly living)  
I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
- 10- Prov. 3:5-7 (Wisdom)  
<sup>5</sup> Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. <sup>6</sup> In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths. <sup>7</sup> Be not wise in your own eyes; fear the Lord, and turn away from evil.
- 11- Is. 41:10 (Fear)  
fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.
- 12- Eph. 4:26-27 (Anger)  
<sup>26</sup> Be angry and do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger, <sup>27</sup> and give no opportunity to the devil.
- 13- Eph. 4:29 (Godly speech)  
Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear.
- 14- Phil. 4:19 (Hope/Trust)  
And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.
- 15- Is. 40:8 (The Word)  
The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God will stand forever.
- 16- James 1:12 (Trials)  
Blessed is the man who remains steadfast under trial, for when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who love him.

17- Col. 3:12-13 (Patience/Forgiveness)

<sup>12</sup> Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience, <sup>13</sup> bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.

18- 1 Peter 1:3 (Gospel)

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

19- 1 Peter 1:4 (Gospel)

to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you,

20- 1 Peter 1:5 (Gospel)

who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

21- Isaiah 40:28-29 (Strength)

<sup>28</sup> Have you not known? Have you not heard? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He does not faint or grow weary; his understanding is unsearchable. <sup>29</sup> He gives power to the faint, and to him who has no might he increases strength.

22- Isaiah 40:30-31 (Strength)

<sup>30</sup> Even youths shall faint and be weary, and young men shall fall exhausted; <sup>31</sup> but they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.

23- 1 Cor. 6:18-20 (Temptation)

<sup>18</sup> Flee from sexual immorality. Every other sin[a] a person commits is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against his own body. <sup>19</sup> Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, <sup>20</sup> for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.

24- Titus 2:11-12 (Gospel)

<sup>11</sup> For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, <sup>12</sup> training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age,

25- Titus 2:13-14 (Gospel)

<sup>13</sup> waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, <sup>14</sup> who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works.

26- Titus 3:1-2 (Church Life)

<sup>1</sup> Remind them to be submissive to rulers and authorities, to be obedient, to be ready for every good work, <sup>2</sup> to speak evil of no one, to avoid quarreling, to be gentle, and to show perfect courtesy toward all people.

27- Phil.2:4-5 (God's Character)

<sup>4</sup> Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. <sup>5</sup> Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus

28- Phil. 2:6-7 (God's Character)

<sup>6</sup> who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, <sup>7</sup> but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men.

29- Phil.2:8-9 (God's Character)

<sup>8</sup> And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. <sup>9</sup> Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name,

30- Phil. 2:14-16 (Godly speech)

<sup>14</sup> Do all things without grumbling or disputing, <sup>15</sup> that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and twisted generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, <sup>16</sup> holding fast to the word of life, so that in the day of Christ I may be proud that I did not run in vain or labor in vain.

31- Heb. 3:12-13 (Church Life)

<sup>12</sup> Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of you an evil, unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living God. <sup>13</sup> But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.

32- Is.43:25 (Repentance)

"I, I am he who blots out your transgressions for my own sake, and I will not remember your sins.

33- Phil. 4:13 (Strength)

I can do all things through him who strengthens me.

34- 1 Peter 5:6-7 (Temptation)

<sup>6</sup> Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you, <sup>7</sup> casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you.

35- 1 Peter 5:8-10 (Temptation)

<sup>8</sup> Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. <sup>9</sup> Resist him, firm in your faith, knowing that the same kinds of suffering are being experienced by your brotherhood throughout the world. <sup>10</sup> And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you.

36- Deut.6:4-5 (Godly Living)

<sup>4</sup> "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. <sup>5</sup> You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.

37- Deut. 6:6-7 (Godly Living)

<sup>6</sup> And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. <sup>7</sup> You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.

38- 2 Cor. 5:17 (Repentance)

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.

39- John 1:1-3 (God's Character)

<sup>1</sup> In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> He was in the beginning with God. <sup>3</sup> All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made.

40- 1 Peter 3:18 (Gospel)

For Christ also suffered[a] once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit,

41- 1 Peter 4:19 (Suffering)

Therefore let those who suffer according to God's will entrust their souls to a faithful Creator while doing good.

42- Romans 12:17-19 (Godly Living)

<sup>17</sup> Repay no one evil for evil, but give thought to do what is honorable in the sight of all. <sup>18</sup> If possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all. <sup>19</sup> Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave it[a] to the wrath of God, for it is written, "Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord."

43- 1 Sam. 12:23-24 (Prayer)

<sup>23</sup> Moreover, as for me, far be it from me that I should sin against the Lord by ceasing to pray for you, and I will instruct you in the good and the right way. <sup>24</sup> Only fear the Lord and serve him faithfully with all your heart. For consider what great things he has done for you.

44- Hebrews 12:1-2 (Repentance)

<sup>1</sup> Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, <sup>2</sup> looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

45- Is. 26:3-4 (Anxiety)

<sup>3</sup> You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you, because he trusts in you. <sup>4</sup> Trust in the Lord forever, for the Lord God is an everlasting rock.

46- Is. 64:4 (God's Character)

From of old no one has heard or perceived by the ear, no eye has seen a God besides you, who acts for those who wait for him.

47- 2 Tim. 2:24-25 (Godly Living)

<sup>24</sup> And the Lord's servant[a] must not be quarrelsome but kind to everyone, able to teach, patiently enduring evil, <sup>25</sup> correcting his opponents with gentleness. God may perhaps grant them repentance leading to a knowledge of the truth,

48- Col. 3:18-19 (Family Life)

<sup>18</sup> Wives, submit to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord. <sup>19</sup> Husbands, love your wives, and do not be harsh with them.

49- Col. 3: 20-21 (Family Life)

<sup>20</sup> Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord. <sup>21</sup> Fathers, do not provoke your children, lest they become discouraged.

50- Gal. 5:22-24 (Godly Living)

<sup>22</sup> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. <sup>24</sup> And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

51- Hebrews 13:5-6 (Godly Living)

<sup>5</sup> Keep your life free from love of money, and be content with what you have, for he has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." <sup>6</sup> So we can confidently say, "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear; what can man do to me?"

52- 1 Thes. 5:15-18 (Prayer)

<sup>15</sup> See that no one repays anyone evil for evil, but always seek to do good to one another and to everyone. <sup>16</sup> Rejoice always, <sup>17</sup> pray without ceasing, <sup>18</sup> give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.
