1. Have you ever lost something really valuable to you? How did you feel about losing it? What did you do to find it?
2. Read Luke 15:1-2, 8-10. What verse or phrase in this chapter stands out to you most? Why?
3. What words does Jesus use to describe the woman's urgent search for the lost coin? What is Jesus' message about "lost people" in this story? Does that message mean anything for you today?
4. Does this surprise you? Can you picture God urgently searching for you? Can you picture God urgently searching for your friends and neighbors?
5. Can you picture God rejoicing over you the way this woman rejoiced over her coin? Do you know that God loves you like that?
6. Do you love people like that? Is there anything that is hindering you seeking the lost in the same way that this woman sought her coin?
