Conversation Questions

- 1. Have you ever been reunited with someone you love after a long time apart? What was it like? Tell the story.
- 2. Read Luke 15:1-2, 11-24. What do you love most in this story? Why?
- 3. In this story, Jesus is teaching about God through the character of the Father. What do we learn about God? What is he like? What do you love most about him in this story? Is there anything that is almost too good to be true?
- 4. What did the son ask for (v.12)? Do you think it was right for the son to ask this? How does your heart react to the father's response here?
- 5. The son came home in verses 19 and 21 wanting to make a deal with his dad, but the father in this story isn't interested in making a deal. Why won't the father let him come back as a servant? What does the father want?
- 6. Have you come home to God? If you have, did you do so as a much-loved child, or have you been trying to come home as a servant? How would your relationship with God look different if you embraced your status as a child of God?
