Conversation Questions

1. Have you ever been angry or jealous about someone else's happiness? Why do you think their happiness made you so upset?
2. Read Luke 15:1-2, 25-32. What verse or phrase stands out to you most? Why?
3. Compare the two sons in this story. In what ways are they both lost? Do you identify more with one brother over the other?
4. Why is the older brother so upset? How is the older brother like the Pharisees and the scribes? How do you think they would have heard this story?
5. In this story, Jesus is teaching about God through the character of the father. What do we learn about God? What is he like? What do you love most about him in this story? Is there anything that is almost too good to be true?
6. Jesus is inviting you to share the Father's joy. Is there anything keeping you from joining the party and sharing the Father's joy?
