### **Conversation Questions**

- 1. Name a courageous person in your life. Why do they inspire you?
- 2. \*Read Exodus 3:1-12. What verse or phrase stands out to you most in this story? Why?
- 3. \*God tells Moses to go to Pharaoh and tell him to let his people go free (v.10). Why is Moses afraid of what God is asking him to do?
- 4. What does God say in verse 12 to give Moses confidence to go and speak to Pharaoh?
- 5. \*Just as God promised to be with Moses, he promises to be with you in whatever you are facing. What keeps you from believing that God is with you (fears, circumstances, experiences)?
- 6. Take a few minutes to ask God to strengthen your ability to trust that "he is with you" in the middle of your fears, circumstances, experiences, etc.
