Conversation Questions

1. *Read Daniel 1:1-8. As Daniel was taken away from his home and into exile, what do you think he was probably afraid of?
2. *Daniel resolved that he would not allow anything in his life that would dishonor God. If you made a similar resolution, what would that mean for you? Be as practical and specific as possible.
3. Daniel made up his mind at the beginning of his time in Babylon that he would not dishonor God while he was there. Why is it harder to make these kinds of difficult resolutions after the fact?
4. *Once again, Daniel demonstrates for us the importance of knowing God's word and meeting with him in prayer. Why is this so essential if we are going to walk with integrity in the world?
5. Take a moment to pray together right now for grace to live in the world with the kind of resolve that Daniel showed. If there's anything specific that you know God is asking you to do differently, share that with your group and pray about it as well.
