KEY TAKEAWAYS

1. Experiencing freedom from whatever holds us back from being true to ourselves, as image-bearers of God, is the way God designed humans to live.
2. The church as a family is radically significant, where everyone is welcomed as an essential part of the whole.
3. God's peace is straight oxygen in a world full of the smog of fear. God's peace is available to you now and every day.
4. Move away from the general, "How's it going?" surface-type questions, to the ones that draw out the heart. For example, try a question like this one, instead: "How are you feeling about this?" A few more examples: "How is this issue affecting your relationship with God?" "Want do you want?" "What do you feel you need right now?" "Can I share my observations of God's grace in your life?"
