Conversation Questions

3. What do these verses teach about "the world"? What do we learn about the world?
4. *What's the difference between enjoying the world that God has made, and the way John warns us about "loving the world" (v.15)?
5. Is there anything in "the world" that is drawing your heart away from the love of the Father? Why do you think John warns against it?
6. If there's anything that is drawing you away from the Father, take a moment to confess that in prayer and ask for grace to love him more today.
