Conversation Questions

1. Share your favorite Christmas memory or family tradition and why it is so significant to you.
2. Was there ever a time when you received a gift that you didn't expect, or a gift that was even better than you thought it would be? What was that gift?
3. Read John 1.9-14. What words, phrases, or ideas stand out to you and why?
4. This passage tells us that God dwelled with us as a human (v.14) and that people didn't recognize Jesus. They weren't expecting him to come as a human. Why do you think it would be good news that God was born and lived as a human being?
5. As a group or as an individual, take the time to thank God for some specific gifts in your life, especially those that you didn't expect.
