Conversation Questions

- 1. *What do you feel like you need to do to get noticed?
- 2. *Read James 2:1-13. What words or phrases stand out to you? Why?
- 3. *What motivation do we have for showing favor to the rich and ignoring or insulting the poor? (v.2-7)
- 4. In what ways does favoritism make us a "judge"? (v.4)
- 5. How does showing favoritism break the command: "Love your neighbor as yourself"? (v.8)
- 6. Is there any person or group of people that you're tempted to look down on, be irritated with, or dismiss? How would remembering God's mercy change the way you feel about them?
- 7. Take some time to talk to God about this and ask for his help to love those people.
