Conversation Questions

1. *"Actions speak louder than words." Where have you seen this demonstrated?
2. *Read James 2.14-26. What words or phrases stand out to you? Why?
3. In verse 16, someone says "Go in peace, be warmed and filled," but does nothing to help them. What does this response tell us about what the person really believes?
4. *In this section, James compares two kinds of faith: faith that is alive and faith that is dead. What's the difference between these two kinds of "faith"?
5. James cites Abraham and Rahab as examples of living faith. What was it about their lives that proved their faith in God?
6. Is there any promise that God has made us that you're struggling to trust and act on? What would acting on that promise look like right now? (If you can't think of one, check out Romans 8.31-32 and then respond.)
