Conversation Questions

1. Could you share about a time when someone spoke a meaningful word to you at the right time? How did it impact you?
2. *Read James 3:1-12. What words or phrases stand out to you? Why?
3. *What are some of things that James compares our tongue to? (For example: the tongue is like a bit in the mouth of a horse – v.3.) What point is he making?
4. How can your words “corrupt the whole body and set on fire the entire course of life?” (v.6)
5. Has there been an example in your life when your words had negative consequences?
6. *James says that your words are one of the most powerful things you have. How could you use your words to “give grace to those who hear” this week? (see Ephesians 4:17-32.)
7. Take a moment to ask God for help to do this.
