Conversation Questions

1. Have you ever been humbled when you thought you were pretty great?
2. *Read 1 Corinthians 1:18-2:5. What verse or phrase stands out to you most? Why?
3. *Take some time to talk about what this passage teaches about God. What does it say he is like? What does he value? How is God different than we are?
4. *How does Paul describe the Corinthians (and us) in verses 26-31?
5. How would these truths about God and humanity (e.g., "God's foolishness is wiser than man's wisdom...") create humility in us and unity among us?
6. Paul says, "For Jews demand signs and Greeks seek wisdom but we preach Christ crucified..." We can all relate to wanting a sign from God to prove himself or wanting to understand God when things are confusing. Why would "Christ crucified" sound foolish? Why would that not sound like wisdom?
7. Is there any place in your life where confidence in your own wisdom is creating conflict with others? Pray for humility.
