**\*QUESTIONS FOR KIDS!** Questions most suitable for children are marked with an asterisk.

### Conversation Questions

1. \*Has anyone ever made a huge positive impact in your life, but they probably wouldn't know? What did they do that was so impactful?
2. \*Read 1 Corinthians 3.1-9. What verse or phrase stands out to you most? Why?
3. Paul says (v.1-2) that the Corinthians are like infants who aren't ready for solid spiritual food. Ouch! What symptoms does he point to as the reason for this diagnosis (v.3-4)?
4. \*What does Paul teach about Christian leadership (v.6-9)? How is Paul's vision different than the world's view of successful leadership?
5. How does the truth: "God gives the growth," (v.7) liberate us from jealousy and strife in the church and set us free to serve with humility and unity?
6. Is there anyone whose leadership, service or gifts you are jealous of? Is there any place where you are taking credit for what God is doing? Confess these things to God. Ask him for grace to serve with humility.
