### Conversation Questions

1. \*Have you ever been underestimated by a teacher, coach or peer? Tell the story.
  
2. \*Read 1 Corinthians 4:1-14. What verse or phrase stands out to you most? Why?
  
3. What do you notice about the sharp contrast between the Corinthians (v.7-8) and the apostles (v.9-13).
  - a. What is Paul trying to help them understand? (Hint: Everything the Corinthians have is a gift. They received it because the apostles became nothing for their sake.)
  
  - b. How would this create humility and unity in the church at Corinth?
  
4. \*Paul intentionally embodied the values of the kingdom (humility, service, weakness, hard work...), but the Corinthians don't value these. They want teachers and leaders who look successful. The Corinthians are wanting heroes to look up to. That's why they like Apollos.
  - a. Where does this same attitude manifest itself in our churches today?
  
  - b. Where does this attitude manifest itself in your life?
  
5. Ask God for help to embrace the values of the kingdom like Paul did.
