### **Conversation Questions**

- 1. Describe a person at work, school or in your life whose character and integrity gives them significant influence.
- 2. \*Read 1 Corinthians 4:14-21. What verse or phrase stands out to you most? Why?
- 3. \*What do you notice about the contrast between Paul's authority (v.18-21) and his description of himself in 4:9-13?
- 4. What "power" do you think Paul is talking about in verses 19 and 20? (Hint: the power is to live out the values of the kingdom.)
- 5. How could you tell if you or someone else is experiencing God's power, or if it's just talk?
- 6. Pastor Tim described two types of relationship we need to cultivate for experiencing God's power; is there a relationship that you are challenged to grow?
- 7. Which of the values of the kingdom is the Spirit prompting you to grow in? Take some time and pray about that value.
