Conversation Questions

1. *Have you ever experienced unfair treatment that turned out for good? Share about it.
2. *Read 1 Corinthians 6:1-11. What verse or phrase stands out to you most? Why?
3. Paul says that followers of Jesus will judge the world (6:2) and angels (6.3)! He implies that they have the wisdom that they need to settle their own disputes (6:5). Why would these truths be so essential to understanding why lawsuits between believers are such a problem?
4. *Why do you think Paul says it would be better for us to be defrauded than to take a brother or sister to court (6:7)? What do you have to believe about God and his justice to be able to do this?
5. Lawsuits always begin as small disputes. Is there anyone that you have something against that you need to go and seek reconciliation with?
6. Now, go judge an angel (6.3).
