**Conversation Questions**

1. Are you single or married? Are there assumptions that people make about what life is like for you that you wish they didn't?
  
2. \*Read 1 Corinthians 7:1-9. What verse or phrase stands out to you most? Why?
  
3. What is Paul's attitude toward sexuality and marriage and how is this different than modern attitudes and assumptions?
  
4. What is Paul's attitude toward sexuality and singleness (v.7-8) and how is this different than modern attitudes towards singleness?

How can married and single people honor one another in the church?

5. What are some reasons that Paul gives for using our bodies to serve one another in marriage (v.3-5)?
  
6. Is there any way that your attitude toward marriage, singleness or sexuality is out of step with God's word? Confess it to God and ask for his help to walk in obedience.
