## Conversation Questions

- 1. \*Have you ever been jealous of aspects of another person's life? Share the story.
- 2. \*Read 1 Corinthians 7:10-24. What verse or phrase stands out to you most? Why?
- 3. The theme of this passage is contentment and peace in whatever circumstance we find ourselves.
  - a. What groups of people does Paul address (example: married, circumcised, servant, etc.) and what advice does he give to each othem about how to exprience peace and contentment? (it might help to write this out)
  - b. Put yourself in the shoes of one of these groups. Which group's situation would challenge your peace and contentment the most? Why?
- 4. \*What truths about God does Paul mention to encourage each group of people? (Again, it might help to write this out.)
  - a."God has called you to peace." (v.15). How do you think Paul's teaching would create peace in our hearts even if our circumstances are less than ideal?
- 5. What truths about God do you need to experience peace right now? Give thanks for these things in prayer and ask for help to experience God's peace in your circumstances.
