3. What "rights" is Paul describing in verses 1-14?
4. Paul says that exercising his right to financial support would have created an obstacle to the gospel (v.12). How would receiving financial support have done that?
5. What is Paul's top priority? How does this priority impact how he exercises his rights?
6. \*What can we learn about reordering our own priorities today? Ask for God's help to put him first in your life.
