Conversation Questions

1. Share about a time when you faced a significant test and you overcame it successfully. What helped you get through?
2. *Read 1 Corinthians 10:1-13. What verse or phrase stands out to you most? Why?

For more background on the story that Paul makes reference to in verses 6-10, feel free to read Exodus 32 and Deuteronomy 25.

3. In verses 1-3, Paul lists a number of significant experiences that everyone in Israel shared together in the book of Exodus.
Even after all of these wonderful experiences, what was the outcome (v.5)?

Why do you think this happens?

4. In Deuteronomy 25 and Exodus 32, after all of the wonderful things God had already done, Israel turned away from God anyway, and many of them died as a result. (This is what Paul is referring to in verses 6-10.)

Paul says that these stories were written down for us as a warning and example (v.11). Why do Christians need warnings like this? (v12)

5. What promises does Paul give us in verse 13? Why is it so hard for us to believe these promises sometimes?

Could you share about a time when you experienced God's help like this? What was it like?

6. Is there any place in your life where you need God's help to escape or endure temptation? Ask for his help right now.
