\*QUESTIONS FOR KIDS! Questions most suitable for children are marked with an asterisk.

#### **Conversation Questions**

- 1. Of all the different stories or teaching in the Bible that you've heard or read about, which have been the hardest for you to accept and believe? Why? Would you mind sharing with your group?
- 2. Read Luke 1:26-38. What do you love most in this story? What stands out to you? Why?
- 3. The promises that the angel makes to Mary are incredible almost unbelievable. Describe the range of emotions and thoughts that Mary must have experienced in verses 29-38.
  - a. There were a lot of things that could have kept Mary from believing God's word (her age, public humiliation, her gender, her social status, etc.) Do you think you would have responded the way that she did in verse 38? Why or why not?
- 4. God doesn't simply leave Mary with the message that she is going to have a baby. He gives her a sign so that she might reassure her heart (v. 36-37).
  - a. What do you think this teaches us about God? How is this good news when you are struggling to believe God?
- 5. Read verses 39-45. In verse 45 Elizabeth says, "Blessed is she who believed..."
  - a. At some point, faith is simply a decision we make to believe God when he speaks. When we encounter really hard things, God is always going to be at work to create beauty and redemption for those who will trust him.
  - b. Have you made that decision to take God at his word? Is there any place in your life where you are struggling to believe God right now? Is there any place where you are waiting for God to redeem something that's hard?

Ask God to help you believe what he has said.
