***QUESTIONS FOR KIDS!** Questions most suitable for children are marked with an asterisk.

Conversation Questions

1. What is your favorite thing about the Christmas season?

2. Read Luke 2:1-20. What verse or phrase stands out to you most? Why?

3. The shepherds were told about something that was pretty amazing and hard to believe. How do you think you would have responded if you were there? Why?

4. Can you imagine modern people choosing to stay outside in the dark rather than going in to Bethlehem? Why do you think people are tempted to be cynical? What are they protecting? What is at stake?

5. There's a distance and sophistication that comes with cynicism. It's cool.
 - a. So why do you think God chose shepherds? What does that teach us about God? How is this good news for us today?

6. The shepherds believed something they hadn't seen yet, and with joy they chose to get up and go see Jesus. It isn't silly or naïve to believe. It's silly to stay outside in the cold.
 - a. Have you made that decision to take God at his word? Is there any place in your life where you are still sitting in the dark because you're afraid of looking naïve or childish?

What is God asking you to do today in light of the shepherd's story? Talk to God about this.
