*QUESTIONS FOR KIDS! Questions most suitable for children are marked with an asterisk.

	Conversation Questions . *What person or group's approval is most important to you? How does that show up in your life?
2.	. Read Galatians 1:10-24 and Acts 9:1-19. What verse or phrase stands out to you most? Why?
3.	. Whose approval mattered most to Paul before he met Jesus (Gal. 1:13-14)? How did that show up in his life?
4.	. Why do you think Paul shares the details about his life before and after meeting Christ with the Galatians? What does he want them to understand?
5.	. After his encounter with Jesus on the way to Damascus, Jesus became everything to Paul, superseding all other associations or the approval of people. Rather than making Paul isolated and independent, this encounter made him more generous in spirit toward people. Why do you think the gospel changes people's hearts in this way?
	a. Has it changed your heart in this way? Is the gospel drawing you toward others without the need for people's approval? Are you becoming more generous in spirit toward others?

Ask God to work in you to make you free from the need to receive the approval of people, and generous toward them at the same time. (Bring specific relationships to the Lord in prayer.)
