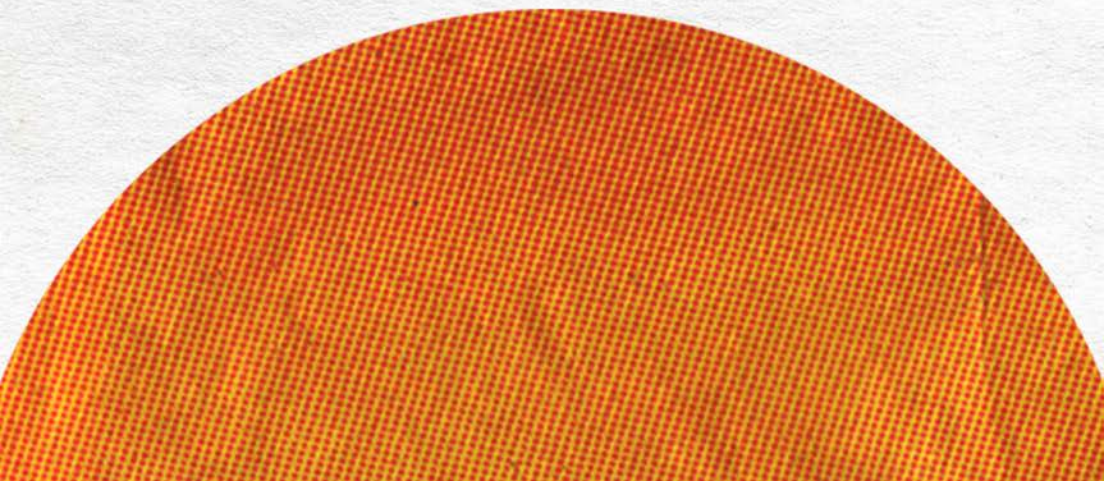

WELCOME!

Over the next twelve weeks, as our church walks through the series “The Serpent, the Slaves and the God of Salvation,” our Daily Bible Reading Guide will take us through Genesis 12-50. On Sunday mornings our teaching will be rooted in Exodus 1-15, where God calls Moses to lead Israel out of slavery in Egypt. In this Daily Reading Guide, we’re going to read through Genesis because that is where the story of Exodus begins. Many of the central themes of Exodus are first planted, shaped, and developed in Genesis.

Genesis introduces us to the God who creates by His word, who is holy and life-giving, who judges evil without surrendering his mercy, and who binds himself to real people with real promises. In other words, Genesis gives us the theological soil out of which Exodus grows. The God who rescues Israel from slavery is the same God who called Abram, Isaac and Jacob by grace.

One of the things you’re going to notice about this reading guide is that some of the assigned readings are a little longer than normal. That, too, is intentional. These chapters are meant to be taken in as whole movements, not just isolated verses. Genesis is a highly structured, tightly woven narrative. Notice patterns in the story. Pay attention to the characters. Look at what God does.

As you read, you will find moments that confuse you, unsettle you, or stretch your understanding of God. That’s great. Genesis refuses to give us a God who is small, safe, or easily managed. Instead, it introduces us to the living God who defines himself, who keeps his promises across generations, and who is never detached from the real story of human life.

INTRODUCING SOAP

Whether you've read the Bible for years or this is your very first time opening it up for yourself, this journal is designed to help you meet with God personally in his word. To help you do that, we're using a simple and proven approach called SOAP. It's an easy-to-follow guide to help you slow down, listen, and interact personally with God in his Word. Here's how it works:

S – SCRIPTURE

Write out a short verse, phrase or theme that stood out to you in your reading. Make a note about why you think that phrase or verse is impacting you today. Writing it down helps you slow down and focus.

O – OBSERVATION

What observations can you make about the passage? This could be notes about the people in the passage, places, or what happens. It's also helpful to write down questions about anything that's initially confusing or that you don't understand. Then you can reflect on, explore, or examine those questions more deeply. If you aren't sure what to write, here are a few questions that are always helpful to ask when you're reading the Bible:

- What am I learning about God – his character, actions and glory?
- What is God doing in this passage?
- What am I learning about myself and humanity? What are we like apart from God's grace?
- Who are we as a result of what God has done in Jesus? What is true about me now?

A - APPLICATION

What is God speaking to me about today? Is there a command to obey? A promise to trust? A warning to heed? An encouragement to receive? What will I need from God to respond in faith today?

P - PRAYER

Talk to God about what you've read. Ask for his help, thank him, or simply respond to what he's shown you.

Don't worry about getting it perfect —just show up each day, read and respond to God. You don't have to be a Bible expert. Just let God meet you here.

HOW THIS READING PLAN WORKS

If this is the first time that you've attempted to read the Bible on a regular basis, this is our challenge: set aside 20 minutes every day. Find a place where you can:

- Sit down and not be disturbed.
- Put your phone and smart watch in another room.
- Have a Bible, your SOAP Journal and pen in hand.

Ideally, this is at a time in the day when you're reasonably "fresh" and awake. Get that first cup of coffee going, but don't open your newsfeed or phone yet. Let this be the first thing on your agenda. If your kids are old enough to understand, let them know that you need 20 minutes to spend time with the Lord and that this is important to you. This is a great opportunity to set an example that may encourage their own love for God's word.

We've created this journal with a daily (Monday-Saturday) reading. On Sundays, there will be a note page for the Sunday sermon. If you miss a day, don't sweat it. Don't worry about "catching up." This isn't a homework assignment or something to check off your to-do list. Meeting with God in his word is a gift - it's about a daily encounter with God. If you miss a day (or ten!), just pick up the reading for that day.

You'll notice that on Sundays, there's no reading plan - just a page for taking notes during the sermon.

Finally, the best way to get the most out of this experience is to be sure that you have an opportunity to talk with a friend about it every week. This is typically the difference between people who "make it" and stick with a reading plan, and those who don't. If you're in a Missional Community or Small Group, bring your SOAP Journals and compare notes. If you're not, find a friend today, set a weekly meeting time and agree to get together during this reading challenge. You won't regret it.

A NOTE ON READING GENESIS 12-50

As we move into Genesis 12–50, the story of the Bible narrows its focus. Instead of tracing the story of all humanity, the story now follows one family – beginning with Abraham – through whom God promises to bring blessing to the whole world. These chapters tell the story of God’s covenant with Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph, showing how God faithfully works through imperfect people to accomplish his perfect purposes.

Unlike the primeval history of Genesis 1–11, which uses broad, sweeping narratives to explain the origins of the world and humanity, Genesis 12–50 is written as family history. It contains detailed stories, real places, emotional struggles, and long journeys. We see moments of great faith and painful failure, sibling rivalry and reconciliation, famine and provision, betrayal and forgiveness. Through it all, one theme remains constant: God keeps his promises, and he redeems the lives of his people.

As you read, it’s important to remember that these stories aren’t about heroes to imitate, but about a faithful God who guides his people despite their weakness. Abraham struggles with fear, Jacob deceives, Joseph is wronged and forgotten – yet God is quietly working in every moment to move his covenant plan forward.

Remember that Genesis is a very tightly woven, carefully crafted work of literature. Everything in there is in there on purpose and has been placed in the story where it is for a specific purpose. You are going to read a number of stories that feel like they are either repetitious, or random. Nothing in Genesis is random, and the structure of the story is a part of how it teaches. If you ever find yourself wanting to know more, we recommend looking specific chapters up at [The Bible Project](#). Their site is full of excellent lectures, podcasts and videos.

Finally, in an effort to get through Genesis in 12 weeks, a few shorter passages have been omitted from this reading plan.

Here are a few tips to help you read Genesis 12–50 well:

1. WATCH FOR GOD'S PROMISES.

Notice how often God repeats and expands his covenant promises — about offspring, land, blessing, and his presence. These promises drive the entire story.

2. PAY ATTENTION TO GOD'S FAITHFULNESS IN ORDINARY EVENTS.

Many chapters don't include dramatic miracles. Instead, God works through family decisions, political events, dreams, and even sinful actions to accomplish his will.

3. NOTICE BOTH FAITH AND FAILURE.

The patriarchs are real people with real struggles. Their stories remind us that God's grace is bigger than human weakness.

4. LOOK FOR HOW GOD'S PLAN IS BIGGER THAN ONE GENERATION.

What God promises to Abraham unfolds slowly across generations, teaching us patience and trust in God's timing.
