Devote yourselves to prayer; stay alert in it with thanksgiving. Colossians 4:2

DAY 1

Revival in the Church

Pray that God will revive the Church and awaken our nation to the greatness and supremacy of Christ. Pray that God will pour out His Spirit on America and forgive our sin and heal our land. Pray that millions of Americans will be convicted by the Holy Spirit, repent of their sins, and turn to God with all their hearts. (2 Chronicles 7:14, Hab 3:2, Acts 2:37-41)

DAY 2

Coronavirus Vaccine

Pray that the coronavirus vaccine will do only what it is designed to do. Ask God to make it accessible to those living in poverty around the world.

DAY 3

American Households Facing Eviction

Millions of American households are facing evictions this month. Ask God to supply their needs (Philippians 4:19) and grant them peace of mind (2 Thess. 3:16) and pray that God would help us to keep our eyes open for opportunities to serve and share Christ with others.

DAY 4

Isolation of the Elderly

The isolation of the elderly puts them at a greater risk for depression, anxiety and mental decline. Ask God to protect them and stop the spread of the virus. Ask God to grant salvation to those who are lost. Pray that they would know Him intimately and sense His presence. Pray that during this time they would bear fruit like trees ever full of sap and green. (Psalm 92:14)

DAY 5

Members of the Senate & House of Representatives

Pray for the members of the Senate and the House of Representatives to find God's peace and direction and for these men and women to act and lead according to Your Word. Ask that God would unify them in righteousness for the sake of the nation.

DAY 6

Single Moms

The pandemic has brought serious challenges for single moms, from losing their jobs to shouldering the burden when children cannot go to school. Pray that God would calm their fears (Psalm 56:3-4), quiet them when they feel overwhelmed, give them clarity, insight, and guidance (Psalm 32:8), and meet their every need. (Philippians 4:19)

DAY 7

Marriage & Family

Pray that Jesus will heal, restore, and strengthen every marriage and family. Pray husbands love their wives and wives will respect and submit to their husbands. Pray that the hearts of parents will be turned toward their children to love them and raise them in a God-honoring way. Pray that children will respect and obey their parents. (Genesis 2:24; Joshua 24:15; Psalm 127:3-5; Malachi 4:6; Ephesians 5:22-23; Ephesians 6:1-4)

DAY 8

Caregivers of Aging Parents

Caregivers of aging parents may find it especially difficult during this time of COVID-19. Pray that God would keep them all safe. Ask Him to give them strength, patience, and compassion, and to help them treat their parents in such a way that reflects the love of Christ. Ask Him to ease their burden and provide times of rest and refreshment.

DAY 9

Healthcare Workers

Pray for our healthcare workers as they are working long hours. Ask God to give them endurance, wisdom and peace. Ask that the Lord would grant them physical, emotional and spiritual rest.

DAY 10

Students, Teachers & Administrators

Ask the Lord to keep students, teachers and administrators at every educational level from all harm. Pray for the Lord to release truth in school and help students to rightly discern truth and not believe false teaching.

DAY 11

Chief Justice & Associate Justices

Pray for the Chief Justice and Associate Justices that God will give them wisdom to make good decisions.

DAY 12

Newly Divorced

Ask God to bless and heal the hearts of the newly divorced. (Psalm 34:18)

DAY 13

Human Trafficking

Human trafficking is prevalent in our state. Ask our Loving Father for His divine protection and to release them from their chains. Pray that He would restore them, provide them a new beginning and to help us reach out in support of victims and survivors.

DAY 14

Widows

Widows may find facing the new year difficult. Ask the Lord to heal the pain and restore joy. (Psalm 147:3) Ask the Lord to help them to put their hope in Him, knowing that He will take care of them. May they trust that He has a hope and a future planned for them. (Jer. 29:11)

DAY 15

Young Women

Our young women are being bombarded with messages on Netflix, Pinterest, texting, Instagram, and Snapchat. Pray that our young women turn to the Word of God. Ask God to help them to listen to the Truth, dwell on it, believe it, and act on it. It is only the Truth that will set them free. (John 8:31-32)

DAY 16

Pastor Buddy Gray

Pastor Buddy needs our prayers. Ask God to grant him wisdom, understanding and strength. Pray that God would help him be encouraged.

DAY 17

Members in Leadership

Pray for the members who are in leadership at Hunter Street. Pray they would seek the Lord at all times and work together in love and unity.

DAY 18

Healing of Racial Divide

Pray to God to heal the racial divide that exists in America. Ask God to heal our nation of racism and to use the church to stand against racial conflict, violence, and prejudice (Romans 10:12-13, Galatians 3:28, Acts 10:28, John 7:24)

DAY 19

Human Life & the Unborn

Pray for life to be valued and protected from conception to death. Pray for God to break the culture of death in America and restore a culture of life. (Ps. 139:13-16; Jeremiah 1:5; Proverbs 24:11; Deut. 21:8-9)

DAY 20

President Biden, VP Harris & Cabinet Members

Pray for President Biden, Vice President Harris, and the Cabinet members to receive wisdom beyond their own understanding and the courage to choose the right path. Ask for God to help them honor and respect Him as the One and only True God

DAY 21

Unsaved Children

Our unsaved children seem to stay in the forefront of our thoughts and prayers. Ask God to help us trust Him for our children's salvation.

DAY 22

Missionaries

Pray for missionaries to confidently proclaim God's Word (Acts 13:4-5) and for favor with unbelievers. (Acts 13:14-15)

DAY 23

The Lost

Jesus wept for Jerusalem because He was not willing that any should perish. (1 Timothy 2:3-6; 2 Peter 3:9) Pray that God would help us be moved like Jesus for the lost and to convict us to pray for them.

DAY 24

Unsaved Parents

Pray for unsaved parent(s) that their hearts will be opened to repent of their sins and receive Jesus as their Savior. Pray for the gospel to radically change their lives. (Matthew 9:37-38; 2 Peter 3:9; Acts 26:18)

DAY 25

Covid-19 & Family Impact

The COVID-19 pandemic has disrupted family routines around the world. For families with children with special needs or chronic conditions, these disruptions are amplified. Pray for God to protect them from the virus. Ask the Lord to refresh them, strengthen them to press on each day. Give them patience, so that they may not become discouraged. Ask God to grant those who live in poverty access to medical care.

DAY 26

New Christians

Pray for new believers to be true disciples of Jesus and share their faith, making more disciples. Ask the Father to surround them with fellow Christians; pray the Father would protect them from negative influences and guard their hearts

DAY 27

Broken Relationships, Family & Children

Ask that God restore broken relationships between parents and children. Pray God would help them to be kind, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave them. (Ephesians 5:32)

DAY 28

Moral Standards of Today's Generation

The moral standard of the generation of today is being shaped by a trend called, "situational morality." Right and wrong is determined by how the outcome makes us feel, giving birth to the "Gender Revolution". Ask God to help us reject this lie and begin to change this untruth. Pray that God would help us to be anchored in the Truth. (Hebrews 6:19)

DAY 29

Single Christians

Ask the Holy Spirit to cultivate in the heart of single Christians a true delight in Jesus.

DAY 30

Elderly & Immunocompromised

Pray for the loved ones of the elderly and immunocompromised who have to be away from them because of COVID-19. Ask God to comfort their hearts.

DAY 31

Suicide

Suicide is the third leading cause of death for those aged 15 to 24. Ask God to help them to cry out to Him to rescue them from any evil influences that are trying to destroy them and to talk to someone about their feelings.
