



SESSIONS SUMMER TOUR 2023 Information Sheet

Ingleside Student Sessions (completed 6th – 12th grade) will be going to Myrtle Beach, South Carolina, the week of **Sunday, June 11 – Saturday, June 17, 2022**. This trip aims to help students use music and the arts to open doors to share the gospel. We will host an arts camp and perform a series of short concerts throughout the week.

- The cost is \$475 if registered with a deposit on or before January 15.
- The cost is \$575 if registered after January 15.
- This cost includes transportation, most meals, supplies, and lodging. Students will learn how to raise money for mission trips in Missions Orientation. In the past, students have raised all money for summer trips by using this method.
- This trip will have a payment schedule as follows:
 - January 15 - \$100 deposit due
 - February 15 - \$75 payment due
 - March 15 - \$75 payment due
 - April 15 - \$75 payment due
 - May 15 - \$75 payment due
 - June 5 - All remaining money due
- Space is limited to the first 50 students who register with a deposit.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Member of Ingleside Baptist Church
- Approved student mission team application located at ingleside.org/go
- Completion of Ingleside Missions Orientation (If a student has already attended the class, they do not need to attend again.)
- Regular involvement in Ingleside Middle or High School Ministry, worship services, and Student Sessions
- A more detailed preparation schedule will be provided at a later date.
- Participation in Church Picnic on June 28

Sessions Tour FAQs

Why should my student go on this mission trip?

To help students be faithful followers of Jesus, we provide opportunities to come to worship, grow in a group, serve in the body, and go with the gospel. This trip is one way for students to live out an essential part of discipleship (Matthew 28:19-20, Acts 1:8). Your student will be stretched spiritually, physically, and emotionally but will experience God's broader work in the world. It opens them up to see the needs of people outside their community and may even open the gate to further missions work later in life.

What's the first step for my student to be involved in this trip?

The first step is for your child to fill out a student mission team application themselves if they have not already done so. These are available online or in Ingleside High School or Middle School ministry areas. Turn this application in at Student Sessions.

Who is this trip for?

This trip is open to all students in grades 6 – 12 who can demonstrate a testimony of faith in Christ and fulfill the requirements listed on the front page.

Can my student recruit a guest outside of Ingleside to go?

No. All of our Ingleside mission trips require participants to be active members of our local fellowship.

Who is leading this trip?

Jonathan Green, our Worship Arts Pastor, will be the key leader for the mission trip. Jonathan has led many trips to Myrtle Beach, New Orleans, New York City, and Hawaii. We will also take 10 to 12 other adults who serve in Student Sessions.

Where will the group stay?

We will be staying at a resort and conference center located on the north side of Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. Each condo can accommodate 10-12 people.

What does the trip cost cover?

In Missions Orientation, students will learn about approved ways of raising financial support through inviting others to give toward the mission of sharing Christ on this Sessions Tour. The cost of this trip covers transportation, most food, lodging, a t-shirt, and ministry supplies. We have worked hard to make this as affordable as possible by supplementing the cost significantly through the Worship Arts budget.
