

ES Children's Ministry Wellness Policies

1. If a child was sick, s/he must be symptom free for at least 24 hours without the use of medication. The child cannot enter the classroom if s/he experiences/has:

- fever of 100 or higher
- vomiting or diarrhea
- conjunctivitis (pink eye or other eye infection)
- rash
- nasal drainage that is green or yellow
- sore throat
- cold
- excessive coughing
- open sores
- lice

*Note: We do not recognize teething as being a cause of fever or diarrhea.

2. If a child develops any of the above-mentioned symptoms while in class, the CM Staff area supervisor will text the parent. If the parent cannot be reached, the child will stay outside of the classroom with staff until the parent arrives.

3. Children with allergies have their allergies listed on their security tags. When the child is dropped off for the first time, the CM Staff will ask the parent if the child has any allergies.
