OVERVIEW

In September 2008, Redeemer initiated an intensive, top-tier training program to equip participants for gospel leadership in New York City and the world.



The Gotham Fellowship is a 9-month learning community designed to broaden your understanding of and deepen your connection to God's redemptive work by applying theology, spiritual practices, and cultural renewal to your work, your relationships, and New York City. Each Gotham class typically includes a balance of women and men with varied professional and personal backgrounds. Cohorts are primarily organized around affiliation with or proximity to the Redeemer churches.

The Gotham Fellowship provides three foundational elements needed for applying the fullness of the gospel and the integration of faith and work:

GOSPEL-CENTERED THEOLOGICAL TRAINING

Drawing from the deep resources of the Reformed tradition, our program develops a worldview and fosters a commitment to consider how the gospel impacts every area of life, from personal relationships to the diverse culture of New York City.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

Gotham cultivates spiritual growth that activates personal and professional development through relationships, daily practices and projects.

COMMUNITY FORMATION

Gotham provides a community of peers, from diverse backgrounds and vocations, who are committed to each other's spiritual growth and calling to serve the common good of the city.

PROGRAM

DETAILS & COMMITMENT

The Fellowship runs from Labor Day Weekend through mid-May. The program incorporates:

- Daily devotionals
- Weekly reading assignments
- Prayer Partners
- Pastoral Mentorship
- Applied projects and exercises
- ▶ Weekly 2.5-hour meetings
- ▶ Five-Monthly Saturday gatherings
- ► Three weekend long gatherings Labor Day, Martin Luther King Jr. Day and a NYC Finale the third weekend in May.

TUITION

\$2850: Redeemer members, \$3250: regular attenders of Redeemer churches. \$3600: for participants from Neighboring Churches. This fee helps offset program expenses, including, but not limited to, reading materials, rental space, and all housing and meals for the retreats. Scholarships and financial aid are available. APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications open in January and the deadline for submission is April 30. An admissions committee selects fellows from applicants who best demonstrate: 1) spiritual maturity, 2) ability to fulfill the responsibilities of the program, and 3) commitment to the city.
