The man blamed his wife. The woman blamed the serpent.

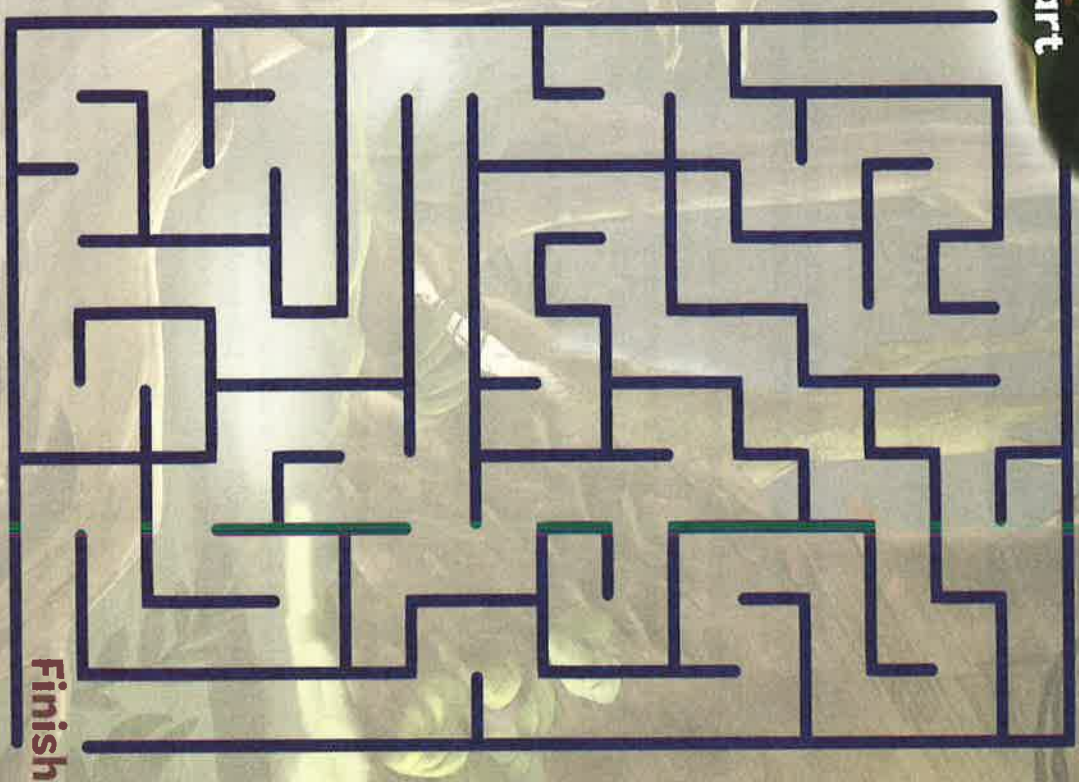
God said bad things would happen. Life would be hard and painful, all because of sin. But God promised that one of the woman's descendants would destroy the serpent. God sent them out of the garden.
